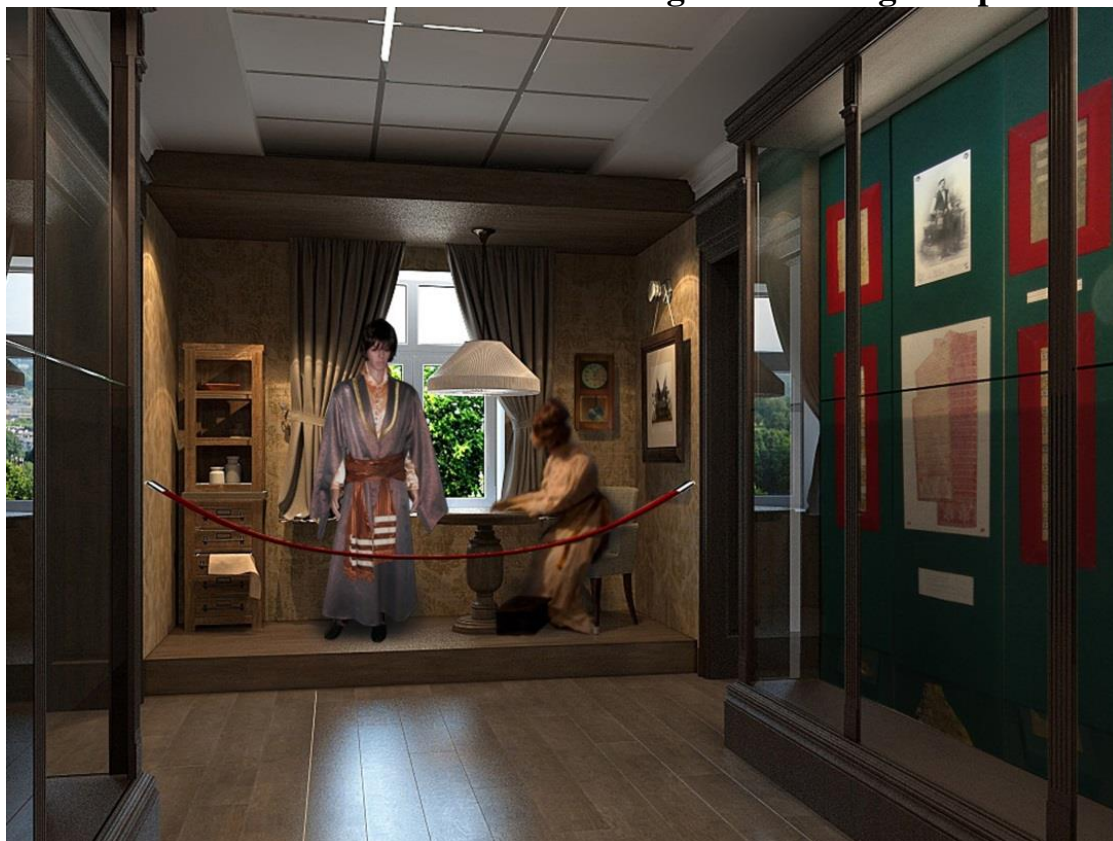


**Humanitarian project

1. Project name: creation of the exposition of the Slutsk Museum of local lore
2. Implementation period: 1 year
3. The organization applicant offering the project: Slutsk Museum of local lore
4. Project objectives: to recreate the Museum facilities and show the visitor the most significant and interesting historical events of the Slutsk region, to tell about the people who glorified the Slutsk land, about the contribution of the region to the national history. To promote the formation of an attractive tourist and cultural image of the region
5. The goals planned to be run in a framework of implementation of the project: 1. To give visitors an opportunity to get a General idea of the development and history of the Slutsk region. 2. To create a dynamic, multi-faceted exposition capable of synthesizing diverse methods of its construction, both plot-shaped and traditional. 3. Reate an atmosphere of time at the exhibition, which includes exhibits. 4. To provide opportunities for the organization of Museum and educational activities the exposition itself and in the premises of interactive zones. 5. Use multimedia, designed primarily for the active interaction of the visitor with audiovisual means
6. Target group: schoolchildren, residents and guests of the city of Slutsk
7. Brief description of the humanitarian project. Creating an exhibition in several stages: Room 1. The animal and plant world of Slutsk region will be presented, which will

be divided into biogroups: the inhabitants of swamps, ponds, forests, meadows and fields. It is planned to provide an opportunity to create an interactive zone for Museum and pedagogical classes of environmental orientation.

Room 2. Exhibits will be placed, telling about the first people living in the territory of the Slusk region.

Room 3. Will reveal the theme of the Principality of Slutsk as part of the Turov-Pinsk Principality, and specific, as part Of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania and the Commonwealth.

Room 4. Covers the work Slutskaya manufactory of Persian sash of the mid-XVIII to mid – XIX centuries.

Room 5. The exhibition, which affects the historical, cultural and economic aspects of the life of the County town of Slutsk, will plunge into the atmosphere of the past, feel like a resident of Slutsk in the second half of XIX – early XX Centuries. Religious and cultural life of Slutsk, industrial production and agriculture, education, trade and transport will be represented in the exhibition by some documents, as well as postcards and photographs of Somir Yukhnin.

Room 6. The hall is dedicated to military events in the territory of Slutsk district. Will be shown documents showing our countrymen on the fronts of various wars.

Room 7. In this section of the exhibition will present the complexes of the materials of the natives of Slutsk region – writers, scientists, athletes, military leaders, all those who put their peaceful work has made a contribution to its history.

Room 8. The exposition will be dedicated to the natives of Slutsk region who have made a significant contribution to the exploration of space.
